LOGLINE

In a trouble-ridden 1976 Northern Ireland, football and writing prospect Anthony's relationship with his brothers comes under danger. Exploring religious divides and the importance of family, Anthony will come face-to-face with the one thing he is trying to fight.

SYNOPSIS

Based on the true story "Reavey Brothers" is set on the nights leading up to 4th January, 1976. The Reavey family, Anthony (Dylan Llewellyn), John-Martin (Niall McNamee), Brian (Kevin Nugent) and matriarch mother Sadie (Geraldine McAlinden), live in a world torn by the atrocities of The Troubles and their reputation in the community is to work tirelessly towards anti-violence. We follow youngest brother Anthony, an aspiring footballer and writer, as he struggles to avoid the mayhem of bitter hatred and violence intertwined within their lives, until that is threatened when conflict arrives on their doorstep.

This is a gripping family drama that explores religious divide, the importance of family and how events beyond their control result in heartbreak.

THE STORY

This film is based on the true story of the Reavey Brother killings. On 4th January 1976 Anthony, John-Martin and Brian, three brothers of eight, were sitting at home watching TV when three masked gunmen broke in and opened fire on them. John-Martin and Brian were killed straight away, while Anthony managed to escape to the bedroom and take cover under a bed. He was shot several times and left for dead, after searching the house the gunmen found no one else and left. Moments later badly wounded Anthony, crawled to a nearby neighbour's house to seek help, sadly Anthony died of a brain hemorrhage in hospital 26 days later.

The whole community of Armagh was shocked by these killings and various members of the family including Eugene Reavey, are still doing wonderful work towards anti-violence related causes.

This film tells the story of the nights leading up to the killings and the night of the devastating killings. This film is made with the complete blessing of the Reavey family and is written and directed by John Reavey, nephew of the three brothers.

I've spent a lifetime imagining how I thought the boys lived their lives. A story told completely from the blood of the family, in a modern approach.

Handling something this delicate has been a strongly heart warming and rewarding process.

During the research period it became clear to me just how much this film meant to not only the community, but to the entire generation which suffered in these times.

Northern Ireland is a small place, and Whitecross is even smaller. These stories are never given public recognition - and it's time to shine a light on them. There are so many stories which have not been told, so many cases which have not been given the respect they deserve. I want to pay tribute to not only the three Reavey Brothers, but everyone who has suffered from the troubles, to be remembered forever.

This piece is bold. This piece is raw. A story surrounded in controversy and 45 years in the making - will finally be told.

Previous accolades include a host of award winning short films, Jamie specialises in Music Video promos, working with major UK and international labels such as Polydor, Sony Music and Universal Music Group.

FAQ'S

IS THE FILM BASED ON TRUE EVENTS?

The story is real, but with a narrative, the film is based on the true events but certain aspects like names and people have been changed or added to enhance the narrative of the story. We used real locations that my uncles visited, drank and played at. These locations were all truly affected by the troubles, a lot of them haven't changed since. - **John Reavey**

WHAT MADE YOU TAKE ON THIS FILM, WHY NOW?

I've always known I was going to make this film. It was always just a matter of when. This story is in my blood, it's part of my story and who I am today. Having sat on this story for so long, I wanted to wait until the perfect opportunity for it. Once I was introduced to the team who would be behind the piece, as well as the lead actor Dylan Llewellyn - I simply knew the time was now. - **John Reavey**

HOW WAS THE FILM FUNDED?

This film was funded through a very successful crowdfunding campaign, in which we achieved over £20,000, 5x more than our initial goal. The overwhelming support that we received, not only, on our crowdfunding, but across all of social media shows how much this story has clearly touched people of all ages, nationalities and cultures. - **Jamie Tarr**

WHAT WAS IT LIKE TO WORK WITH DYLAN LLEWELLYN ?

Dylan's approach to taking on this role, sits with myself and the Reavey family in an important place. The attention to detail in the character, and creating a vision of my past uncle to life was a delicate experience - but one Dylan approached with the upmost respect. From colleagues, we became friends - which enabled us to connect about the story and character of Anthony on a level beyond what a character description says on paper. - **John Reavey**

We hope as many people, in as many festivals can enjoy the film and truly learn something from this powerful story. This film should serve as an example of the conflict that is caused when we let our differences divide us.
